Problem Statement

Prior to the pandemic, Fordham University (FU) offered in-person tutoring in limited subject areas and began offering virtual tutoring to undergraduate students in March 2020. Though successful, the new approach proved labor intensive and required significant monitoring.

Opportunities

FU originally sought a solution that would enhance their multiple tutoring networks, with the three main opportunities for improvement being:



Opportunity #1: Increase Accessibility & Engagement

Existing tutoring resources were not best suited for many students, or tutors.



Opportunity #2: Foster Meaningful Professional Development

Students needed access to rich part-time work opportunities that would help prepare them for post-collegiate careers.



Opportunity #3: Improve ROI

FU desired eliminating wasted funds due to unutilized drop-in hours, which would save thousands of dollars each semester.

The Solution: Virtualize & Scale Peer Tutoring



In October 2021, Fordham University launched a Knack Managed Peer Tutoring Program, providing:

- Course-specific peer tutoring for students, by students
- Flexible scheduling that fits the needs of their students
- Scalable virtual, part-time jobs providing meaningful professional development opportunities (while only paying per session)

Impact



~30% of Fordham's Students Used Knack

By the end of spring '22, 1,335 students were using Knack, with sessions being completed in 66 unique courses.



176% Increase in Tutors Between Fall & Spring Semesters

109 sponsored tutors covered 140 of the 183 supported courses.



100% Average Satisfaction

100% of Knack users at Fordham responded that their tutoring sessions were "Excellent," "Very Good," or "Good." 100% also said they would "definitely" recommend Knack to a classmate or friend!
